Galaad. Where can I find the jpg? A: If you have a Intel/Pentium computer, you can use a program called Pico (You can create an ISO from it in about 10 seconds, with minimal time and effort. This ISO can be used to boot your Mac. Alternatively, you can create an external drive and boot your Mac from the drive. You may need a USB dongle, which will be better. If you have a Raspberry Pi, you can use Pico and create an ISO, but it will be much slower than a USB dongle.
