High-resolution computed tomography (HRCT) is a powerful tool to visualize airway disease and to estimate the degree of bronchial wall thickening. The aim of this study was to identify predictive factors for varying degrees of bronchial wall thickening by HRCT. We included 87 patients with asthma who underwent chest CT as part of their routine clinical care. We applied a novel method of segmentation of the bronchi and quantified the extent of bronchial wall thickening as an estimate for airway remodeling. The clinical and spirometric data were correlated with this measurement. High-resolution CT was significantly associated with severity markers such as FEV1 (% pred), FVC (% pred), total IgE, blood eosinophils, and sputum eosinophils. The extent of bronchial wall thickening was significantly correlated with the percentage of the predicted FEV1 (% pred) and the blood eosinophils, which were also significantly associated with the extent of bronchial wall thickening. The presence of remodeling with extensive airway wall thickening may indicate worse disease status in patients with asthma Q: "The user did not match the credentials of a sql login."
