The 94-year-old Democrat announced in an op-ed published in The New York Times that he's not running for the Democratic nomination for president in 2020. "I've decided that I'm not going to run for president," Carter wrote. "But if I was still young enough, I'd consider it." Carter, who was president from 1977 to 1981, ran unsuccessfully for the Democratic nomination in 1976, losing to President Gerald Ford in the general election. A statement posted on his campaign website last week said the former president would explore a bid for Georgia governor. His son, former Gov. and current Sen. Jimmy Carter, said his dad made the decision on his own, without consulting him. "I was surprised by this announcement," Sen. Carter said in the statement. "However, I will always be grateful for the legacy of public service that he continues to leave, and will miss him deeply." Even though the former president is no longer weighing in on the 2020 presidential race, he has spoken out about the pandemic and his own reaction to it. In his op-ed published Monday, he wrote that he's concerned about the impact of the coronavirus on American politics. "The thought of the horrors that coronavirus can cause is heartbreaking," Carter wrote. "Yet there's an even more important downside. The severe restrictions we are experiencing on movement, travel and business are moving us toward a very unhealthy presidential election campaign in which both parties will be under severe pressure to take extreme positions and demonize their political opponents."
